

AFFIDAVIT DECLARING CONSENT TO REVOCATION

Andrew George Adams, III, after being duly sworn, states as follows:

1. That Andrew George Adams, III was licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on December 4, 2001;
2. That Andrew George Adams, III submits this Affidavit Declaring Consent to Revocation pursuant to Rule of Court, Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13.L.
3. That Andrew George Adams, III's consent to revocation is freely and voluntarily rendered, that Andrew George Adams, III is not being subjected to coercion or duress, and that Andrew George Adams, III is fully aware of the implications of consenting to the revocation of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia;
4. Andrew George Adams, III is aware that there are currently pending thirteen investigations into allegations of misconduct, the docket numbers for which are set forth above, and the specific nature of which are here set forth:

08-033-072151 (Candace Wheat), in which the Complainant contends that she paid the Respondent \$400 to handle her child support case, but that he did not file a motion as agreed, and refused to refund any of her fee when she discharged him twelve days later, (although he issued a full refund when she complained to the bar the following month); VS B Docket No. 08-033-075263 (Chris A. Jones), in which the complainant paid the Respondent \$350 toward a \$900 fee for a bankruptcy case, provided the Respondent with necessary records, but the Respondent left

town with no forwarding information and without completing the matter, without accounting for the fee paid, and without returning the records which the Complainant needed for tax returns; VSB Docket No. 09-033-075888 (Nikki Paterson), in which the Complainant paid the Respondent for a bankruptcy case, but the Respondent did not file the matter, did not communicate with the Complainant, and left town without completing the matter; VSB Docket No. 09-033-075986 (Tasha M. Lee-Jackson), in which the Complainant paid the Respondent for adding a creditor to a closed bankruptcy case, but the Respondent did not file the matter, did not communicate with the Complainant, and left town without completing the matter; VSB Docket No. 09-033-076249, in which the Respondent overdrew his attorney escrow account by more than one thousand dollars without explanation; VSB Docket No. 09-033-076317 (James Edward Gary) in which the Complainant hired the Respondent to handle a bankruptcy petition, but he did not attend to the matter promptly, and did not file to re-open the case as agreed after it had been dismissed; ~~VSB Docket No. 09-033-076547 (Sarita Michelle McLean) in which the Respondent was hired for a bankruptcy matter but did not file or complete it;~~ VSB Docket No. 09-033-076871 (Catherine R. Neve) in which the Complainant and her mother paid the Respondent to file their respective bankruptcy cases, but the Respondent never filed the petitions; VSB Docket No. 09-033-076942 (Victoria Rose Wallmeyer) in which the Complainant hired the Respondent to file an uncontested divorce, paid the Respondent in full, but the Respondent left his practice without notifying the Complainant and without completing the matter, and without leaving a forwarding address for the Complainant, who could not locate the Respondent; VSB Docket No. 09-033-076963 (Charles Pearce) in which the Complainant paid the Respondent to file his bankruptcy matter, but the Respondent never did so; VSB Docket No. 09-033-077931 (Rosella Fant) in which the Complainant hired the Respondent to file a bankruptcy, paid all of the legal fees (about \$1000), but the Respondent never filed the bankruptcy, left his practice without notice, and the Complainant could not locate him; VSB Docket No. 09-033-078019 (Loretta Davis) in which the Complainant hired the Respondent for a divorce in 2007 but the Respondent did not advance the matter and did not communicate with the Complainant; VSB Docket No. 09-033-078152 (Alan N. Gibson) in which the Complainant hired the Respondent in 2006 for his divorce and bankruptcy matters, but the Respondent did not advance the divorce case.

5. Andrew George Adams, III acknowledges that the material facts upon which the allegations of misconduct are predicated are true; and

6. Andrew George Adams, III submits this Affidavit and consents to the revocation of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia because he knows that if the disciplinary proceedings based on the said alleged misconduct were brought or prosecuted to a conclusion, he could not successfully defend them.
