AFFIDAVIT DECLARING CONSENT TO REVOCATION

Spiros S. Anthony, after being duly sworn, states as follows:


1. That Spiros S. Anthony was licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on 03/13/1970;
2. That Spiros S. Anthony submits this Affidavit Declaring Consent to Revocation pursuant to Rule of Court, Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13-28.
3. That Spiros S. Anthony's consent to revocation is freely and voluntarily rendered, that Spiros S. Anthony is not being subjected to coercion or duress, and that Spiros S. Anthony is fully aware of the implications of consenting to the revocation of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia;
4. Spiros S. Anthony is aware that there is currently pending before the Disciplinary Board of the Virginia State Bar an Order of Suspension dated May 27, 2010 (Suspension Order") and a hearing on a Rule to Show Cause set for June 25, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. the docket number(s) for which is set forth above, and the specific nature of which is here set forth:

That on April 12, 2001 the Circuit Court of Loudoun County entered an order accepting a plea agreement and guilty plea of Spiros S. Anthony of one count of embezzlement, a violation of § 18.2-111 of the Code of Virginia.

5. Spiros S. Anthony acknowledges that he is the same person identified in the copy order of conviction attached to the Suspension Order ; and



Anthony submits this Affidavit and consents to the revocation of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia because he knows that if the disciplinary proceedings based on the Rule to Show cause were brought or prosecuted to a conclusion, that a revocation would be the likely result and he wishes to cooperate fully with the Bar in this matter.
