AFFIDAVIT DECLARING CONSENT TO REVOCATION

I, Charles Edward Ayers, Jr., after being duly sworn, state as follows:

1. I was licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on 01/30/1974;
2. I submit this Affidavit Declaring Consent to Revocation pursuant to Rule of Court, Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13-28.
3. That my consent to revocation is freely and voluntarily rendered, that I am not being subjected to coercion or duress, and that I am fully aware of the implications of consenting to the revocation of my license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia;
4. I am aware that there is currently pending a complaint, an investigation into, or a proceeding involving, allegations of misconduct, the docket number for which is set forth above, and the specific nature of which is here set forth below:


a Show Cause Proceeding requiring me to appear and show cause on June 19, 2013 why the alternative sanction of revocation of my license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia should not be imposed for my failure to comply with the Terms imposed by the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board (Board) in its Order imposing a Public Reprimand with Terms against me, entered November 20, 2001, in the case styled *In the Matter of Charles Edward Ayers, Jr.*, Virginia State Bar Docket Number 94-032-0554 (2001 Order). The Notice of Show Cause Hearing on Terms Failure filed by the Virginia State Bar sets forth the alleged violations in detail and is incorporated by reference. I acknowledge that I entered into the transactions referenced in the Notice of Show Cause Hearing and that I violated Term 1 of the 2001 Order by participating in a business transaction with my client and that my license to practice law in the Commonwealth of

Virginia should be revoked as required by the 2001 Order.

6. I submit this Affidavit and consent to the revocation of my license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia because I know that I cannot show compliance with Term 1 of the 2001 Order.


