AFFIDAVIT DECLARING CONSENT TO REVOCATION

Lorenzo Lee Bean, III, after being duly sworn, states as follows:

1. That Respondent, Lorenzo Lee Bean, III, (hereinafter "Respondent") was licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on October 5, 1982.
2. That Respondent submits this Affidavit Declaring Consent to Revocation pursuant to Rule of Court, Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13-28.
3. That Respondent's consent to revocation is freely and voluntarily rendered, that Respondent is not being subjected to coercion or duress, and that Respondent is fully aware of the implications of consenting to the revocation of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
4. Respondent is aware that there is currently pending a complaint, an investigation into, or a proceeding involving, allegations of misconduct, the docket number for which is set forth above, and the specific nature of which is here set forth in paragraphs 5 through 8.
5. In September of 2012, Complainant and his ex-wife, (hereinafter "Complainant") retained Respondent to represent them in an Offer and Compromise with the IRS to settle joint tax liens from 2008 and 2009. Respondent represented Complainant's ex-wife in the divorce.
6. The Complainant paid \$18,325.01 into Respondent's trust account to pay the IRS

tax liens and associated filing fees.

7. Respondent withdrew funds held in trust for Complainant for an unauthorized use.

8. Respondent acknowledges that the material facts upon which the allegations of misconduct are predicated are true.



Respondent submits this Affidavit and consents to the revocation of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia because he knows that if the disciplinary proceedings based on the said alleged misconduct were brought or prosecuted to a conclusion, he could not successfully defend them.
