**SUMMARY ORDER OF IMPAIRMENT SUSPENSION**

This matter came for consideration upon receipt from the Clerk of the Disciplinary System of the Virginia State Bar copies of: 1) an Order entered on June 17, 2008 by the Court of Appeals of Maryland in the case of Attorney Grievance Commission of Maryland v. David William Bodley placing David William Bodley's license to practice law in the State of Maryland on inactive status by consent; and 2) Joint Petition for Order Placing Respondent on Inactive Status and Affidavit endorsed by David William Bodley and filed with the Court of Appeals of Maryland.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, and it otherwise appearing proper so to do, it is hereby ORDERED pursuant to Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13(I)(6)(d) of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia, that David William Bodley's license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia shall be and hereby is suspended upon entry of this Order due to Impairment.


It is further ORDERED that David William Bodley shall give notice, by certified mail, of the suspension of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia to all clients for whom he is currently handling matters and to all opposing attorneys and presiding judges in pending litigation, and shall make appropriate arrangements for the disposition of any matters presently in his care in conformity with the wishes of his clients, pursuant to the requirements of Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13(M) of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia.

It is further ORDERED that the Clerk of the Disciplinary System shall send a certified copy of this Order by certified mail, return receipt requested, to David William Bodley at his last

address of record with the Virginia State Bar, 112 Front Street, Pocomoke City, Maryland 21851,  
and at his last known address, 51 Ridge Avenue, Edgewater, Maryland 21037.
