ORDER

THIS MATTER came to be heard on November 22, 2010 via duly noticed teleconference upon the Virginia State Bar's Motion to Lift Stay of Sanction and to Re-impose Disciplinary Sanction and Respondent's written opposition thereto. M. Brent Saunders, Assistant Bar Counsel, appeared on behalf of the Virginia State Bar, and Respondent appeared *pro se*.

The Court finds that: i) the Public Reprimand With Terms imposed in this matter was automatically stayed upon Respondent's filing on February 16, 2010 of a Notice of Appeal of the Memorandum Order entered in this case on December 15, 2009; ii) Respondent's six-month period of probation commenced January 1, 2010 and was stayed on February 16, 2010; and iii) Respondent's appeal of the Memorandum Order entered in this case on December 15, 2009 was dismissed on May 10, 2010 and Respondent's petition for rehearing was denied by order entered on September 23, 2010 and no further appeal is possible.


Upon consideration of the foregoing, and the pleadings and arguments of the parties, it is **ORDERED** that the Three-Judge Court's sanction of Public Reprimand With Terms is hereby re-imposed. It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that the six-month

period of probation shall be deemed to have recommenced as of September 23, 2010.


The Clerk of the Disciplinary System shall comply with all requirements of Part 6, §IV, ¶13 of the Rules of Court, as amended, including but not limited to assessing costs pursuant to ¶13-9E. of the Rules, and complying with the public notice requirements of ¶13-9G of the Rules.




