CONSENT ORDER

THIS DAY CAME the Virginia State Bar (the "Bar"), by its Assistant Bar Counsel Paul D. Georgiadis, and Respondent, Harvey D. Coleman, by counsel Charles M. Lollar, pursuant to Pt. 6, §IV, ¶13-23 of the Rules of the Virginia Supreme Court and represented to the Virginia State Disciplinary Board that Respondent suffers from a medical condition which has materially impaired his ability to practice law and in support thereof, provided an uncontradicted written report (the "Report") by a reputable physician outlining the specifics and history of Respondent's naturally caused (unprovoked) medical condition, and

It appearing to the Board by virtue of the endorsement of Assistant Bar Counsel that the Bar is satisfied that the written Report furnished to it on behalf of the Respondent supports the claim that he suffers from an impairment as defined in Pt. 6, §IV, ¶13.A of the Rules of the Virginia Supreme Court; and

It further appearing to the Board that Respondent has voluntarily retired from the practice of law and Respondent, by counsel, has agreed to the temporary suspension of his law license until such time as it is established that Respondent no longer suffers from an impairment as defined in Pt. 6, §IV, ¶13.A of the Rules of the Virginia Supreme Court.

It appearing proper to do so, it is hereby

ORDERED that the law license of Harvey D. Coleman is hereby temporarily suspended until such time as it is established that Respondent no longer suffers from an impairment as defined in Pt. 6, §IV, ¶13.A of the Rules of the Virginia Supreme Court and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all proceedings and the written Report filed in this matter and maintained by the Clerk of the Disciplinary System remain confidential in accordance with the Rules of the Virginia Supreme Court;


