ORDER

These matters came on to be heard before the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board on October 23, 2008, upon the Virginia State Bar's Notice of Noncompliance and Request for Suspension in VSB Docket Nos. 07-070-2327, 07-070-064880, and 07-070-070159 and the Respondent's response; upon the Respondent's Motion to Dismiss Certification in VSB Docket Nos. 07-070-2042, 07-070-2327, 07-070-064880 and 07-070-070159, and exhibits and supporting memorandum therewith; upon the Virginia State Bar's response; upon the Respondent's Motion to Consolidate and supporting memorandum and the Virginia State Bar's response; and was argued by Assistant Bar Counsel, Alfred L. Carr, and Walter Franklin Green, IV's (Respondent) counsel, Janipher W. Robinson.

The Chair swore in the Court Reporter, who was Tracy J. Johnson, RPR, CCR of Chandler and Halasz, Post Office Box 9349, Richmond, Virginia 23227. The Chair then inquired of each member of the panel whether he had any personal or financial interest which would impair, or reasonably could be perceived to impair, his ability to be impartial, and each member and the Chair replied in the negative. The panel was comprised of Joseph R. Lassiter, Jr., Arthur G. McGowan, Gordon P. Peyton, Dr. Theodore Smith (lay member) and Robert E. Eicher, Chair.

Following argument, the Board went into closed session to deliberate and then reconvened to announce its decision.

I. Notice of Noncompliance.

It appearing from representations of counsel that they have resolved their dispute regarding the subpoenas and agree on a dismissal with prejudice of the Notice of Noncompliance, it is ORDERED that the Notice of Noncompliance be and hereby is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

II. Motion to Dismiss Certification.

It is ORDERED by a majority vote of the Board that the Seventh District Subcommittee's certification to the VSB Disciplinary Board in VSB Docket Nos 07-070-2042, 07-070-2327, 07-070-064880 and 07-070-070159 be and hereby is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

III. Consolidated Motions

(1) Respondent's Motion to Set Aside Summary Order in VSB Dockets Nos. 06-070-2259, 06-070-0739 be and hereby is DENIED.

(2) Respondent's Motion to Expunge Suspension in VSB Docket Nos. 03-070-3720, 05-070-2448, 05-070-2540, 05-070-3011 and 05-070-3625 be and hereby is DENIED.


(3) Respondent's Motion to Dismiss VSB Docket No. 07-070-2248 be and hereby is DENIED.
