AFFIDAVIT DECLARING CONSENT TO REVOCATION

Lucy Ivanoff, after being duly sworn, states as follows:

1. That Lucy Ivanoff was licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on 04/15/2002;
2. That Lucy Ivanoff submits this Affidavit Declaring Consent to Revocation pursuant to Rule of Court, Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13-28.
3. That Lucy Ivanoff's consent to revocation is freely and voluntarily rendered, that Lucy Ivanoff is not being subjected to coercion or duress, and that Lucy Ivanoff is fully aware of the implications of consenting to the revocation of her license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia;
4. Lucy Ivanoff is aware that there is currently pending a complaint, an investigation into, or a proceeding involving, allegations of misconduct, the docket number(s) for which is set forth above, and the specific nature of which is here set forth:


On May 29, 2014, a Subcommittee entered a Private Reprimand with Terms accepting an Agreed Disposition with Terms. The terms of the Private Reprimand required Ms. Ivanoff to Reimburse Ronnie Shelton the sum of \$4,000.00 and to provide quarterly reports from a licensed C.P.A. certifying that her trust account in compliance with Rule 1.15 of the Virginia Rules of Professional Conduct. Ms. Ivanoff has not complied with these terms and a Rule to Show Cause has been issued returnable to November 20, 2014.

5. Lucy Ivanoff acknowledges that the material facts upon which the allegations of misconduct are predicated are true;

6. Lucy Ivanoff submits this Affidavit and consents to the revocation of her license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia because she knows that if the disciplinary proceedings based on the said alleged misconduct were brought or prosecuted to a conclusion, she could not successfully defend them; and

7. Pursuant to Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13-28.B, nothing contained in this Affidavit shall be deemed an admission in any proceeding except one relating to Ms. Ivanoff's status as an attorney of the Virginia State Bar.
