LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 219

MULTIPLE CLIENTS – WITHDRAWAL.

It is not improper for an attorney to represent two clients in a joint motion that assault charges filed by each against the other be dismissed so long as there is a reasonable expectation that each charge would be dismissed and so long as the attorney has fully disclosed to each the necessity of his withdrawing from representation of either party should both charges not be dismissed.
