LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 255

CONFLICT – PARTITION SUIT –
FORMER CLIENT OR NEW LAW
PARTNER.

It is not improper for attorney "X" to continue representing "A" in a partition suit after forming a law partnership with attorney "Y", who had initially but not currently represented "B" (the opponent of "A") in the partition suit, so long as both "A" and "B" consent to continuation by "X" after full disclosure.
