LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 256

CORPORATE COUNSEL – CONFLICT.

It is improper for a former corporate counsel, who resigned both as corporate director and corporate counsel because of differences among the directors, to undertake to represent one of the directors in litigation resulting from the controversy.
