COMMISSIONER IN CHANCERY –
ATTORNEY.

It would be improper for the attorney who in his capacity as a commissioner in chancery reported on accountings involving the same estate in an earlier suit, to represent as counsel, and file a suit for, the beneficiaries of the estate. [See II: DR:9-101(A) & (B).]
