LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 293

DISCLOSURE ON SETTLEMENT.

Where two opposing attorneys reach an out of court settlement prior to appeal to the Circuit Court based on the erroneous assumption that the appeal bond posted by the appellant would not be refunded, it is improper not to disclose to other counsel that a refund has been made. [See II: DR:1-102(A)(4), DR:7-101(B)(1) and DR:7-102(A)(3).]
