CONFLICT OF INTEREST/PERSONAL

It is not ethically improper for an attorney to represent a wife in a personal injury case against her husband after the husband has been found guilty in absentia by the attorney's law partner sitting as a substitute judge in General District Court in a hearing regarding a traffic violation.
