LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 547

CRIMINAL ACTION – ACCORD AND
SATISFACTION.

It is not improper for counsel for a criminal victim to seek accord and satisfaction in exchange for the dismissal of the criminal charge by the Commonwealth, when the criminal charge is already pending, independent of any action by the victim's counsel.
