LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 563

FEE – THIRD PART PAYMENT.

It is not improper for an attorney, who acts as his client's financial advisor in evaluating an investment opportunity, to receive part or all of his fee from the third party who markets the investment opportunity so long as his client has given consent thereto, after full and adequate disclosure under the circumstances.
