LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 581

PART-TIME COUNTY ATTORNEY –
PERSONAL INJURY
REPRESENTATIVE.

It is not improper for a part-time County Attorney, who is not responsible for the prosecution of violations of county traffic ordinances, to represent personal injury litigants whose injuries resulted from accidents which led to charges of violations of county ordinances.

It is improper for the County Attorney to represent persons charged with violations of county traffic ordinances. [DR:9-101; LE Op. 188]
