LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 607

GUARDIAN AD LITEM –
COMPENSATION BY ADVERSE
PARTY.

It is not improper for an attorney serving as an inmate's guardian ad litem to be compensated for his services by the adverse party in a suit for a no-fault divorce brought by the inmate's wife, when the attorney has given the inmate full and adequate disclosure and the inmate has consented thereto.
