LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 615

WITNESSES – PAYMENT OF PRIVATE
INVESTIGATOR.

It is improper for a law firm to enter into a compensation agreement with a private investigator in which the investigator will be paid for his services rendered out of any settlement or award resulting from the two personal injury cases which the private investigator is handling, when the use of the private investigator as a rebuttal witness cannot be ruled out.
