LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 637

CONFLICT OF INTEREST – SUIT
AGAINST FORMER CLIENT.

It is not improper for an attorney who represented a minor, through his mother, in a product liability claim, thereafter to represent the minor against his mother for negligence arising from the same claim so long as the mother has given her consent after receiving full and adequate disclosure from the attorney. [DR:4-101(C)(1), DR:5-105(D)]
