LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 684

COMMONWEALTH'S ATTORNEY'S –
PART-TIME PRACTICE – PARTNERS –
CONFLICT OF INTEREST.

It would not be improper for the other members of the law firm of a part-time assistant commonwealth's attorney to defend criminal cases in the jurisdiction where the part-time commonwealth's attorney prosecutes only welfare fraud and child support enforcement cases so long as the assistant commonwealth's attorney has no contact with or responsibility for the Commonwealth's cases in which members of his law firm are appearing as defense counsel.
