LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 702

APPEARANCE OF IMPROPRIETY –
FORMER COMMONWEALTH'S
ATTORNEY.

It is improper for a former assistant commonwealth's attorney to represent the victim of a malicious wounding in a personal injury suit against the perpetrator when said attorney, in his former capacity as an assistant commonwealth's attorney, prosecuted the malicious wounding charge against the perpetrator.
