LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 754

OFFICE SHARING – CORPORATE
CLIENT.

Where an attorney seeks to share offices with a corporate client, he is required to: (1) post a sign identifying his office at the main entrance; (2) maintain separate and secure files and office space; (3) maintain separate and distinct telephone listings; and (4) properly effect a change in address such as notifying clients, courts, bar associations, and changing stationery and business cards.
