CONSENT ORDER FOR IMPAIRMENT SUSPENSION

This day came Respondent Rebecca Louise Marquez (Respondent) and represented to the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board that she suffers from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), Major Depression Chronic-Moderate, Impulse Control Disorder, and Borderline Personality Disorder. Respondent asserted that each of these conditions constitute Impairments, as defined at the Rules of the Supreme Court Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-1. Respondent further asserted that each of the foregoing conditions materially impairs her fitness to practice law.

WHEREAS Respondent has stopped practicing law as a result of the Impairments;

WHEREAS Respondent is no longer representing any clients;

WHEREAS Respondent has agreed that, pursuant to the Rules of Court, Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-23.A, Respondent shall be suspended from the practice of law in the Commonwealth, and that the term of Respondent's suspension shall be indefinite, and, except as provided at Paragraph 13-23, shall be terminated only upon determination by the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board that Respondent no longer has the Impairment; and

WHEREAS the instant proceeding is a private and confidential matter, no professionals' findings will be released by the Bar to the public; and

WHEREAS, it appearing proper to do so under Paragraph 13-23, and by consent of Respondent:

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the license of Respondent Rebecca Louise Marquez to practice law in Commonwealth of Virginia is **SUSPENDED** indefinitely.


2. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent shall comply with the requirements of Paragraph 13-29. Issues concerning the adequacy of the notice and arrangements required shall be determined by the Board, which may impose a sanction of revocation or further suspension for failure to comply with the requirements of this paragraph.


