CONSENT ORDER OF IMPAIRMENT SUSPENSION

This day came the Virginia State Bar by its Assistant Bar Counsel Paul D. Georgiadis and the Respondent William Magruder McKee, *pro se*, and represented to the Disciplinary Board that Mr. McKee suffers from physical maladies that have led ~~the~~ <sup>one of many</sup> Social Security Administration to find him "disabled" and to grant him an award of "total disability" effective on or before June 30, 2011. *pdg mm*

~~In making a determination for disability status and disability benefits awards, the Social Security Administration defines disability as "the inability to engage in any substantial gainful activity (SGA) by reason of any medically determinable physical or mental impairment(s) which can be expected to result in death or which has lasted or can be expected to last for a continuous period of not less than 12 months." This Social Security finding is a higher level of disability than the Impairment standard before this Board. The Rules of Court define attorney impairment as "any physical or mental condition that materially impairs the fitness of an Attorney to practice law." Pt. 6, §IV, ¶13-1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia. Thus, Mr. McKee has been found not only incapable of engaging in his employment as an attorney, but incapable of any employment by reason of his disability.~~

The bar now has ~~four (4)~~ misconduct complaints now pending against Mr. McKee arising from allegations of neglect and or failure to communicate.

Based upon the aforesaid clear and uncontroverted evidence of impairment, Mr. McKee has agreed that he suffers from an Impairment as defined in ¶13-1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia and further agrees to an indefinite impairment suspension pursuant to Pt. 6, §IV, ¶13-23 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia until it is established that he no longer suffers from an Impairment.

It appearing proper to do so under ¶13-23 of the Rules, it is hereby

ORDERED that the license of William Magruder McKee to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia is SUSPENDED indefinitely effective ~~February 3, 2012.~~ *September 7, 2012.* It is further

ORDERED that the Respondent shall comply with the requirements of ¶13-29 of


the Rules. Issues concerning the adequacy of the notice and arrangements required shall be determined by the Board, which may impose a sanction of revocation or further suspension for failure to comply with the requirements of this paragraph. It is further
