AFFIDAVIT DECLARING CONSENT TO REVOCATION

I, Stephen Lee McPherson, after being duly sworn, state as follows:

1. I was licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on October 15, 1996;
2. I submit this Affidavit Declaring Consent to Revocation pursuant to Rule of Court, Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13.L.;
3. My consent to revocation is freely and voluntarily rendered, I am not being subjected to coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the implications of consenting to the revocation of my license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia;
4. I am aware that there is currently pending a complaint, an investigation into, or a proceeding involving allegations of misconduct, the docket number for which is set forth above, and the specific nature of which is here set forth:


On January 23, 2009, in Chesapeake Circuit Court I pled guilty to and was found guilty of four felonies: to wit; two counts of forcible sodomy and two counts of object sexual penetration, all involving minors in my custody and care. I also currently face similar charges in Virginia Beach Circuit Court.

5. I acknowledge that the material facts upon which my pleas of guilty in Chesapeake Circuit Court were predicated are true;
6. I submit this Affidavit and consent to the revocation of my license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia because I know that if the disciplinary proceedings based on

the said alleged misconduct were brought or prosecuted to a conclusion, I could not successfully defend them; and

7. I acknowledge the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia prohibit me from petitioning to have my law license restored for at least five years from the date of the order revoking that license.


