AFFIDAVIT DECLARING CONSENT TO REVOCATION

Robert C. Oliver, Jr. , Respondent, after being duly sworn, states as follows:

1. That Respondent was licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on June 5, 1967;
2. That, pursuant to Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13 (L) of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia:
 - A. Respondent's consent to revocation is freely and voluntarily rendered, that Respondent is not being subjected to coercion or duress, and that Respondent is fully aware of the implications of consenting to a revocation of Respondent's license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia;
 - B. Respondent is aware that VSB Docket No. 05-022-3356 is currently pending against him and alleging violations of the Rules of Professional Conduct concerning competence, diligence, communication, and safe-keeping property, as set forth in the attached Certification dated June 27, 2006.
 - C. Respondent acknowledges that the material facts upon which the allegations of Misconduct are predicated are true; and
 - D. Respondent submits this Affidavit and consents to the Revocation of Respondent's license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia because Respondent knows that if the disciplinary Proceedings based on the said alleged Misconduct were prosecuted to a conclusion, Respondent could not successfully defend them.
3. Respondent agrees that as of the date of execution of this Affidavit, he will accept no further legal matters and will continue to practice law only on existing legal matters previously accepted by him or entrusted to him.
4. This revocation is effective January 15, 2007.
