SUMMARY ORDER OF IMPAIRMENT SUSPENSION

This matter came for consideration upon receipt from the Clerk of the Disciplinary System of the Virginia State Bar copies of an Order of Appointment of Limited Guardian and Conservator entered on June 18, 2014 by the Circuit Court of Fairfax County in the case of Beverly Stephenson, Civil Action No. 2014-5360, adjudicating Beverly Gray Stephenson to be incapacitated and to be in need of a limited guardian and limited conservator at this time.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, and it otherwise appearing proper so to do, it is hereby ORDERED pursuant to Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-23D of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia, that Beverly Gray Stephenson's license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia shall be and hereby is suspended upon entry of this Order due to Impairment.

It is further ORDERED that Beverly Gray Stephenson shall give notice, by certified mail, of the suspension of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia to all clients for whom he is currently handling matters and to all opposing attorneys and presiding judges in pending litigation, and shall make appropriate arrangements for the disposition of any matters presently in his care in conformity with the wishes of his clients, pursuant to the requirements of Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-29 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia.

It is further ORDERED that the Clerk of the Disciplinary System shall send a certified copy of this Order by certified mail to Beverly Gray Stephenson at his last address of record with the Virginia State Bar, 4157 Chain Bridge Road, Fairfax, Virginia 22030-4102, and a copy hand-
