**CONSENT ORDER FOR THE APPOINTMENT
OF A RECEIVER AND INJUNCTION**

THIS MATTER came before the Court this 29th day of November, 2007, upon a Petition filed by the Virginia State Bar requesting appointment of a receiver and other relief respecting the law practice of Stephen Thomas Conrad and Stephen T. Conrad, Esq., P.C., and upon the Affidavit of Virginia State Bar Investigator David W. Jackson; and

IT APPEARING to the Court by virtue of the endorsements appearing below that Respondents Stephen Thomas Conrad and Stephen T. Conrad, Esq., P.C., do not contest the allegations contained in the Petition filed herein, and consent to the entry of further Orders granting the relief requested therein by the Virginia State Bar; and

IT APPEARING to the Court that that there is reasonable cause to believe that Respondent Stephen Thomas Conrad is engaging in activity which is in violation of the Rules of Professional Conduct and which will result in loss of property of one or more clients or third parties, and that the granting of the requested relief is required to prevent

such losses; it is therefore

ORDERED that:

1. The Order Authorizing Inspection of Records and Documents entered herein on the 14th day of November, 2007, against Respondents Stephen Thomas Conrad and Stephen T. Conrad, Esq., P.C., be, and the same hereby is, continued in full force and effect pending further Order of this Court;

2. Respondents Stephen Thomas Conrad and Stephen T. Conrad, Esq., P.C., are enjoined from withdrawing any bank deposits related to the law practice or law office or disposing of any other law practice or law office assets belonging to the said Respondents or subject to the Respondents' control; and

3. Richard S. Mendelson, Esquire, a discreet and competent attorney be, and hereby is, appointed to receive all funds or property belonging to or subject to the control of the said Respondents, such appointment to be effective upon the posting of a surety bond in the sum of \$ 75,000.00, and to continue until further Order of this Court. The Receiver, upon application to this Court, shall be entitled to recover any costs incurred and to receive a reasonable fee for services rendered, in accordance with the provisions of Section 54.1-3936.E. of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended.

4. The Receiver shall have all of the powers and duties conferred upon receivers as specified by Section 54.1-3936.D. of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, the provisions of which are hereby incorporated herein by reference, and shall specifically take the following actions:

a. Take control of any and all accounts and funds held by the said

Respondents related to the law practice or law office, and over which accounts and funds Respondent Stephen Thomas Conrad has signatory authority.

b. Determine which individuals and/or entities are entitled to receive monies or funds relating to cases on which Respondent Stephen Thomas Conrad performed any services as an attorney.

c. Determine the manner and amount of disbursements to said individuals and entities.

d. Report to the Court all disbursements of said monies and funds for any clients' past accounts that had been made, based upon such information and any records that may be available to the Receiver; and it is further

ORDERED that the Receiver appointed by this Court shall enter, inspect, and copy, as necessary, all clients' records, papers, files, computer entries or any other data located at Respondent Stephen Thomas Conrad's law office at 1986 Opitz Boulevard, Woodbridge, Virginia 22191, or which are located at any other addresses; and it is further

ORDERED that the said Respondents shall not move, destroy, or in any manner alter any records, papers, files, computer entries, or any other data located in Respondent Stephen Thomas Conrad's law office, referenced above, or at any other locations; and it is further

ORDERED that the Court file in this case, and all papers filed therein be, unsealed; and it is further

ORDERED that the Receiver shall file an initial accounting and report of the Receiver's actions not later than four months following the date of entry of this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court certify copies of this Order and cause

them to be served by the appropriate Sheriffs upon


