

2008 MID-ATLANTIC BANKRUPTCY CONFERENCE

This year's Mid-Atlantic Bankruptcy Conference will be held on October 17 and 18 at the Boars Head Inn in Charlottesville. For the first time the Mid-Atlantic will have Friday afternoon breakout sessions on issues related to consumer bankruptcies and issues related to business bankruptcies. On the consumer side there will be a program on challenging proofs of claim, real estate loans, and post confirmation modifications. This will be followed by a Judges Panel where the bankruptcy judges from the Eastern and Western Districts of Virginia will comment on the issues they see in consumer cases. The business bankruptcy breakout sessions will feature Professor David Epstein speaking on hot topics in Chapter 11 and a program on stay relief. This combined programming makes this the one conference you need to attend if you practice bankruptcy law in Virginia.

Because the new conference facilities at the Boars Head will not be completed by the date of this year's conference, space will be limited. With bankruptcy work increasing and with this year's expanded programming, we expect that seats will go fast. It is strongly recommended that you make your room reservations now and that you register for this year's Mid-Atlantic just as soon as you receive your registration materials.
