

**MOTION TO AMEND BYLAWS OF THE BANKRUPTCY LAW SECTION**

**VIRGINIA STATE BAR**

WHEREAS the Bylaws Of The Bankruptcy Law Section Virginia State Bar were last approved by Virginia State Bar Council in February 1990, as subsequently amended in October 1990 and October 1999 (together, the “Bylaws”), and

WHEREAS the Board of Governors of the Bankruptcy Law Section has undertaken a review of the Bylaws for purposes of revising and updating them; it is hereby

MOVED that the Bylaws be revised to correct grammatical errors as follows:

1. In Article II, Section 2, that “. . . members . . . shall continue as members so long as the retain their eligibility . . . .” be amended to “. . . members . . . shall continue as members so long as they retain their eligibility . . . .” (Emphasis added solely for clarification in this Motion).

2. In Article III, Section 3, that “the Chair . . . shall appoint new member sufficient to constitute a quorum.” be amended to “the Chair . . . shall appoint new members sufficient to constitute a quorum.” (Emphasis added solely for clarification in this Motion).

3. In Article V, Section 2, that “. . . shall be approved by the Chair of the Secretary” be amended to “. . . shall be approved by the Chair or the Secretary”. (Emphasis added solely for clarification in this Motion).

4. In Article VI, Section 1, that “Rule of Order” be amended to “Rules of Order”.

(Underscoring present in original Bylaws.)

5. In Article VII, Section 2\*, that “. . . Sections have authority to raise their dues up \$35.00 . . . .” be amended to “. . . Sections have authority to raise their dues up to \$35.00 . . . .” (Emphasis added solely for clarification in this Motion.)
