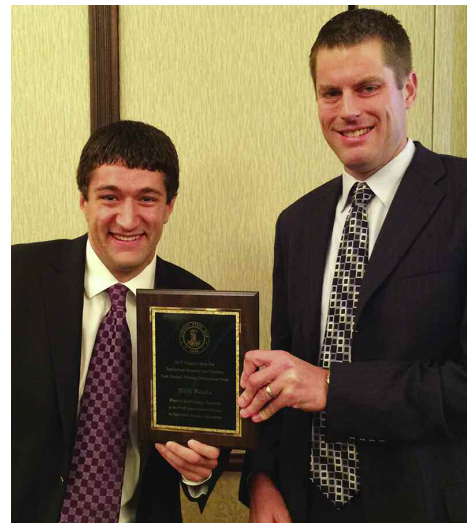

UR Graduate Receives Award

The VSB Intellectual Property Section presented its 2015 Law School Student Writing Competition award to Billy Raska, a 2015 graduate of the University of Richmond Law School. Raska's paper was titled "Where to Start? Adding Objectivity to the Profit Apportionment Process in Reasonable Royalty Calculations." The award was presented at the section's 27th annual fall CLE meeting in Alexandria.

Each year, the IP Section runs the Law School Student Writing Competition for students at law schools in Virginia or Virginia residents attending law schools outside of the state. The winning paper is chosen by former section chair Judge Richard Linn of the US Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit. The winner receives recognition by the section and a \$5,000 cash award.
