

MINUTES OF THE 64TH ANNUAL MEETING

President Michael A. Glasser called the general session of the 64th annual meeting of the Virginia State Bar to order at 9 a.m. on June 15, 2002, at the Cavalier Hotel, Virginia Beach. He introduced Bernard J. DiMuro, the incoming president, who had been sworn in by Virginia Supreme Court Chief Justice Harry L. Carrico the previous evening. Mr. DiMuro reported on the actions of the council at its meeting on June 13.
