IMPAIRMENT SUSPENSION ORDER

This day came the Bar, by Assistant Bar Counsel Edward L. Davis, the Respondent, Frederick Lockhart Caldwell, Esquire (Mr. Caldwell), individually, and his Guardian ad litem, Thomas O. Bondurant, Esquire, and represented to the Disciplinary Board of the Virginia State Bar that Mr. Caldwell suffers from severe depression, as well as ongoing, severe back, neck, and migraine pain that so materially impair his ability to practice law that he has ceased the practice of law. As such, Mr. Caldwell currently suffers from an Impairment, as that term is defined in Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13.I.6 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia (Paragraph 13), and his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia should be suspended under Paragraph 13(I) (6) until it is established he no longer suffers from an Impairment.

It appearing proper to do so under Paragraph 13(I) (6), it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Frederick Lockhart Caldwell, Sr. to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia is SUSPENDED indefinitely.


It is noted that the Virginia State Bar will dismiss for exceptional circumstances all open disciplinary actions against the Respondent, specifically VSB Docket Numbers 04-021-2406, and 04-021-2282, in accordance with Paragraph 13 (I) (6) (a).

It is further ORDERED that the Respondent shall comply with the requirements of Paragraph 13(M) of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia. Issues concerning the adequacy of the notice and arrangements required shall be determined by the Board, which may impose a sanction of revocation or further suspension for failure to comply with the requirements of this paragraph.
