

Issues concerning the adequacy of the notice and arrangements required herein shall be determined by the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board, which may impose a sanction of revocation or suspension for failure to comply with the requirements of Paragraph 13.M.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Disciplinary System shall assess costs pursuant to Rules of Court, Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13.B.8.c.





I. Jeremy C. Sharp, after being duly sworn, state that the following is true and correct:


1. This consent is freely and voluntarily rendered, that I am not being subjected to coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the implications of consenting to Revocation.
