AFFIDAVIT DECLARING CONSENT TO REVOCATION

Robert Spencer Lewis, after being duly sworn, states as follows:

1. I was licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on October 1, 1992.

2. I am over the age of twenty-one and am competent to make the statements contained herein.

2. I represented the Martinsville/Henry County Rescue Squad in a matter adverse to Landsco, Inc. and other defendants, including Sanford Glickauf.

3. Mr. Glickauf gave me a cashier's check payable to my client in the amount of \$2500.00 to satisfy a judgment. I secured my client's endorsement of the check, but did not remit the \$2500.00 to my client.

4. That, pursuant to Part Six, § IV, ¶ 13.L. of the *Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia*:

- a. My consent to revocation is freely and voluntarily rendered, that I am not being subjected to coercion or duress, and that I am fully aware of the implications of consenting to a revocation of my license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia;
- b. I am aware that there is currently pending an investigation into a complaint involving allegations of Misconduct, the docket number for which is set forth above, and the specific nature of which is set forth above;
- c. I acknowledge that the material facts upon which the allegations of Misconduct set forth above are true; and

- d. I submit this Affidavit and consent to the Revocation of my license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia because I know that if the disciplinary proceedings based on the said alleged Misconduct were prosecuted to a conclusion, I could not successfully defend them.
