

Affidavit Consenting to Revocation

Jamie Scott Osborne, after being duly sworn, states as follows:

1. He was admitted to the practice of law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on April 23, 1999, and was active and in good standing to practice law in Virginia until September 29, 2004, when he was administratively suspended for his failure to comply with a subpoena duces tecum issued in connection with a bar investigation.

2. VSB Docket No. 05-000-2199 is a show cause proceeding in which the issue is whether Mr. Osborne complied with the requirements of Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13.M. of the Rules of Court after he was administratively suspended on September 29, 2004.

3. He admits that he failed to comply with the requirements of Paragraph 13.M. of the Rules of Court and that he continued to maintain a law office and hold himself out as a lawyer (via office signage and a telephone directory listing) after the Disciplinary Board administratively suspended his law license.

4. There are currently two other disciplinary matters pending against Mr. Osborne, VSB Docket Nos. 04-060-3592 and 05-060-2326.

5. VSB Docket No. 04-060-3592 arises from his acceptance of a fee to represent the complainant in a divorce proceeding. He admits that he failed to work diligently on the matter, failed to communicate with the complainant and did not refund her money until after she filed a

bar complaint, thereby violating Rules of Professional Conduct 1.3(a), 1.4(a) and 1.15(c)(4).


6. VSB Docket No. 05-060-2326 arises from Mr. Osborne's failure to communicate with a client who engaged him to assist her in connection with a no-fault divorce proceeding. He admits that he failed to communicate with the complainant, thereby violating Rule of Professional Conduct 1.4(a).

7. Due to his failure to comply with the Interim Suspension Order, the requirements of Paragraph 13.M. of the Rules of Court and the Rules of Professional Conduct set out above, Mr. Osborne consents to the revocation of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia pursuant to Paragraph 13.L. of the Rules of Court.

8. He has freely and voluntarily rendered his consent to the Revocation of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia, without being subjected to any coercion or duress, and understands the implications of consenting to the Revocation of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

9. Mr. Osborne acknowledges that he is surrendering his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia because he cannot prevail in the show cause proceeding scheduled for January 28, 2005, and does not wish to contest any Charges of Misconduct that might result from the two disciplinary matters still under investigation.
