CONSENT TO REVOCATION ORDER



By tendering his Consent to Revocation at a time when allegations of Misconduct are pending, the nature of which are specifically set forth in the attached Affidavit, Respondent acknowledges that that the material facts upon which the allegations of Misconduct are pending are true.

The Board having considered the Affidavit, and Bar Counsel having no objection, the Board accepts his Consent to Revocation.

Upon consideration whereof, it is therefore ordered that Timothy George Hayes's license to practice law in the courts of this Commonwealth be and the same hereby is revoked, and that the name of TIMOTHY GEORGE HAYES be stricken from the Roll of Attorneys of this Commonwealth.

AFFIDAVIT DECLARING CONSENT TO REVOCATION

Timothy George Hayes, after being duly sworn, states as follows:

1. That Timothy George Hayes was licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on April 27, 2006.

2. That Timothy George Hayes submits this Affidavit Declaring Consent to Revocation pursuant to Rule of Court, Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13-28.

3. That Timothy George Hayes's consent to revocation is freely and voluntarily rendered, that he is not being subjected to coercion or duress, and that he is fully aware of the implications of consenting to the revocation of his license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia;

4. That Timothy George Hayes is aware that there is currently pending a complaint, an investigation into, or a proceeding involving, allegations of misconduct, the docket number(s) for which is set forth above, and the specific nature of which is here set forth:

a. On January 9, 2018, Timothy George Hayes entered a plea of no contest to a felony charge of Distribution/Manufacturing Schedule I/II Controlled Substance in violation of Virginia Code Section 18.2-248. Thereafter, the Circuit Court of Tazewell County found facts sufficient to support a finding of guilt.

b. On May 8, 2018, the Circuit Court of Tazewell County entered a Conviction and

sentencing Order finding Timothy George Hayes guilty of a felony charge of Distribution/Manufacturing Schedule I/II Controlled Substance in violation of Virginia Code Section 18.2-248. The Court imposed a sentence of five years, with four years eight months suspended.

c. On October 9, 2018, the Circuit Court of Tazewell County entered an Order -Failure to Qualify for Program based on his ineligibility to enter the SECOR program and resented him to five years, with four years five months suspended.

5. Timothy George Hayes acknowledges that the material facts upon which the allegations of misconduct are predicated are true; and

6. Timothy George Hayes submits this Affidavit and consents to the revocation of his license to practice law in Virginia because he knows that if the disciplinary proceedings were brought or prosecuted to a conclusion, he could not successfully defend himself or show cause by clear and convincing evidence why his license should not be revoked.
