LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 1050

CONFLICT OF INTEREST –
COMMONWEALTH'S ATTORNEY.

You advise that the assistant Commonwealth's attorney in your area has been requested to assist in the collection of delinquent real estate taxes by the county board of supervisors. The duties of the assistant Commonwealth's attorney would include collection of delinquent accounts in relation to subdivision lagoon fees, water and sewer fees, and greenbox rentals and emptying fees.

You wish to know whether a conflict of interest would exist should the assistant Commonwealth's attorney perform the services described above.

The Committee opines that no inherent conflict exists on the facts you have submitted. However, if you wish to submit more specific facts, the Committee will be happy to consider them.
