LEGISLATOR-ATTORNEY –
PRIVATE FIRM.

It is improper for a legislator-attorney (who is not precluded from private practice) to allow his name to be continued in association with his private law firm unless he actively continues to practice as a member thereof. [See II: DR:2-102(B).]
