LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 222

REPRESENTING CLIENT'S WITNESS IN
SEPARATE CASE ADVERSE TO
CLIENT – CONFLICT OF INTEREST.

It is improper for an attorney to represent his client's girlfriend in a personal injury action by the girlfriend against the client, when girlfriend is the chief witness in behalf of the client in a separate suit against a restaurant for having served the client an adulterated drink.
