LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 227

DIVORCE – CONFIDENCES –  
CONFLICT.

It is improper for attorney to represent one spouse in a divorce when the other spouse had previously consulted attorney's firm regarding a divorce even though that other spouse has now employed another firm and the instant grounds for divorce are unrelated to the grounds discussed initially with attorney's firm.
