LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 229

CONFLICT IN INTERESTS – PERSONS  
OTHER THAN CLIENT.

It is improper for an attorney representing a client who has been permitted to maintain a class action in *forma pauperis* to accept compensation for such representation from one other than his client unless the client consents and the court approves after full disclosure.
