LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 277

LAW PARTNERSHIP – CESSATION OF
PRACTICE OF LAW – RETENTION OF
PARTNER’S NAME.

Where an attorney partner ceases to practice law, no longer shares space in the law office, but is otherwise engaged full-time in the operation of a business venture, the remaining partners may not retain his name in the firm name or in the listing of the attorneys on the letterhead.
