LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 285

COMMONWEALTH'S ATTORNEY –
CONFLICT OF INTEREST.

It is improper for a Commonwealth's Attorney to represent the estate of the deceased in a wrongful death action when the Commonwealth's Attorney participated in the preliminary hearing at which the charge of involuntary manslaughter was dismissed against the potential defendant.
