LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 288

COMMONWEALTH'S ATTORNEY –  
DECISION TO PROSECUTE.

A Commonwealth's Attorney should proceed with any criminal case despite the victim's desire to dismiss the charge if the Commonwealth's Attorney believes that the evidence is sufficient for conviction and that the prosecution of the case is in the best interests of justice.
