PERJURY – DUTY TO REPORT.

Where an attorney has received information clearly establishing that a person, not his client, has perpetuated a fraud upon a tribunal, his ethical duty does not extend beyond his obligation to reveal the fraud to the tribunal pursuant to DR:7-102(B)(1).
