LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 371

CONFLICT OF INTERESTS.

Attorney Z represented clients A and B on unrelated matters. Some time after the attorney undertook to represent A and B, A became adverse to B. It is improper for Attorney Z to continue to represent either A or B in the matter in which they are adverse to one another and he must withdraw from representing both clients.
