LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 376

FRAUD – DUTY TO REPORT.

An attorney has an affirmative duty to report a fraud perpetrated by an individual, not his client, upon a tribunal. No such duty exists when the fraud has been perpetrated upon a person other than a tribunal. [See DR:7-102(B)(1).]
